Powering up: The surging demand for wire, cables, tubes, and pipes in Southeast Asia

Opportune business landscape for the co-located trade fairs <u>wire</u> and <u>Tube</u> Southeast Asia from 20-22 September 2023 at BITEC, Bangkok, which will gather 300 exhibitors from 30 countries representing the end-to-end ecosystem for the wire, cable, tube, and pipe sectors.

From raw materials suppliers/component suppliers to wire and cable manufacturers, including fibre optics specialists, renewable energy solution providers, energy and consumption reducing ferrous (steel) wires, pipe and tube processing machinery and more.

20 June 2023 - The wire, cable, tube, and pipe sectors in Southeast Asia are poised for significant growth in the coming years, driven by rapid urbanisation, infrastructure development, and increasing internet penetration in the region. This surge in demand for wire, cable, tube, and pipes is fuelled by their versatile applications across various industries, including upstream, midstream, and downstream sectors. Additionally, the automotive, household appliances, and consumer electronics industries are expected to further boost demand. In 2022, the Asia-Pacific region accounted for the largest revenue share of the wire and cables industry, with a market share of 37.4%.

Against this dynamic backdrop and favourable business landscape, wire and Tube Southeast Asia will co-locate once again from 20-22 September 2023 at BITEC, Bangkok. The three-day trade fairs will feature 300 exhibitors from 30 countries including 7 national and country groups - Austria, China, Germany, Italy, Taiwan, UK and USA - representing the end-to-end ecosystem for the wire, cable, tube, and pipe sectors. Exhibiting companies will include raw materials suppliers, component suppliers, wire and cable manufacturers, fibre optics specialists, renewable energy solution providers, and machinery suppliers for pipe and tube processing, among others. The exhibitor list includes prominent brand names such as Maillefer Extrusion OY, Hitachi High-tech Analytical Science GmbH, Rautomead Limited, Schlatter Industries AG, Upcast Oy, and local stalwarts Marposs (Thailand) Co Ltd and Greensource (Thailand) Co. Ltd. More than 9,000 trade visitors from the region are expected to attend, representing industries such as automotive, oil, gas, construction, energy, transportation, telecommunications, the electrical sectors and many others.

Alongside machinery, equipment and solutions, wire and Tube Southeast Asia 2023 will also see several side events taking place: conferences, technical presentations, and business matching activities. How do we reconcile the contradictions of social economic growth versus social responsibility towards the environment? How can the wire and tube industries move towards a more sustainable future? These are some areas that will be discussed during the 2-day international conference: 'Towards a Sustainable Future – Transforming Challenges into Opportunities', jointly organised by Messe Düsseldorf Asia and the International Wire and Machinery Association (IWMA). The conference comes against a timely backdrop as the region steps up efforts to achieve economic growth and decarbonisation.

Southeast Asia in the spotlight

With Southeast Asia emerging as one of the world's fastest-growing energy and power markets and with an estimated increase in energy demand of up to 60% by 2040, driven primarily by coal, the wire and cable market in the region is set to expand significantly. The region's growing population and rapid industrialisation are major contributors to the rising demand for electricity. In response to the pressing need to address climate change and reduce dependence on non-renewable energy sources, there has been a substantial increase in renewable energy investments.
